

Addendum to the City of East Helena’s Facility Use Agreement Regarding Permissible Group Size and Physical Distancing

In keeping with Governor Bullock’s May 19th directive adopted in its entirety by Lewis and Clark County Health Officer Drenda Niemann for the second phase of the phased reopening of Montana, the City of East Helena will resume renting city facilities on June 1, 2020 under the conditions listed in the directive:

Phase Two: Increases the Permissible Group Size to Groups of 50

- Effective June 1, avoid gathering in groups of more than 50 people in circumstances that do not readily allow for appropriate physical distancing. Further, it is recommended to continue to social distance in gatherings of any size.
- Groups larger than 50 people should be cancelled unless physical distancing can be maintained.
- If you are planning an event with more than 50 people you should consult with your local public health office on a plan to implement adequate social distancing.
- Consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s (CDC) guidelines, event cutoff threshold is at the discretion of community leadership based on current circumstances in your community.
- Physical distancing guidelines for groups and gatherings do not apply to household members.
