

2018 East Helena Residential Yard Waste Disposal Site

In an effort to reduce the City of East Helena's landfill tonnage costs we are going to allow yard waste clean up & recyclable metal to be hauled to 3301 Plant Road. The site will be manned by a Public Works Employee. An [East Helena Residential Tri County Disposal landfill permit](#) will be required. Permit applications are available at City Hall or on the Public Works page at www.easthelenamt.us.

Tri County (Valley View Landfill) is located at 300 HWY 518, East Helena. Valley Views hours are Monday thru Friday 7:00am to 3:00pm, Saturday closed. Sunday 8:00am to 3:00pm.

The City of East Helena Residential Yard Waste Disposal Site at 3301 Plant Road will officially open Wednesday, May 2, 2018. The site will be open weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., and Saturdays from 8:00-10:00 a.m.

Allowable items will have to be unloaded separately in their appropriate areas.

The tree limb and brush pile will eventually be burned. Only clean, easily burnable material is allowed. Tree limbs of 4" or less are allowed, brush is allowed, and clean unpainted lumber is allowed. No material that has synthetic bonding agents are allowed in brush pile. No items with any paint are allowed. Pallets are not allowed.

Tree limbs larger than 4" must be limbed and cut to 15" lengths. It will be piled separately. Large stumps need to be piled separately.

The grass and leaf pile will eventually be hauled to the landfill. Our intention is to dry it prior to taking to landfill to reduce tonnage. No plastic bags or tramp material are allowed. A garbage can will be on site to dispose of plastic bags.

Recyclable scrap metal will be allowed, there is a dumpster to put it in.

No household solid waste will be allowed. Household solid waste has to go to Tri County (Valley View Landfill).

No commercial dumping will be allowed.

No wet paint is allowed, it is considered hazardous material. Wet paint has to go to Helena's transfer station and resident will have to pay to unload it.
