The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Montana Environmental Trust Group LLC (METG), Trustee of the Montana Environmental Custodial Trust, are hosting a virtual Public Meeting to update the community on the cleanup and redevelopment activities at the former ASARCO Smelter Facility in East Helena.

The meeting will provide the public with an important opportunity to learn about the ongoing remedial action implementation activities to address soil and groundwater contamination from the former ASARCO Smelter in East Helena. The public meeting will include a brief presentation, updating the public on the status of the remedial activities and the corresponding response of the arsenic and selenium groundwater plumes, as well as additional redevelopment initiatives for the former ASARCO properties in East Helena.
